FIVE PRAYER MODELS

ACTS

- **A**—Adoration: praising God for who He is
- **C**—Confession: owning our sins
- **T**—Thanksgiving: thanking God for all he has done
- **S**—Supplication: prayers of request for ourselves and others

PARTS OF PRAYER

- **P**—Praise
- **A**—Ask
- **R**—Repent
- **T**—Thank
- **S**—Share

FIVE PRAYER MODELS

FIVE-FINGER PRAYER

- **Thumb:** Pray For Those Closest To You
- **Pointing Finger:** Pray For Those Who Guide Us: Teachers, Doctors, Counselors, Mentors
- **Middle Finger** (Tallest One): Pray For Those Who Lead Us: Government, Civic, And Business Leaders, Police And Firefighters
- **Ring Finger (Weakest One)** Pray For Those Who Are Weak: The Poor, Sick, Disabled, Infants, Homeless, The Powerless, Disabled, Infants, Homeless, The Powerless, The Persecuted
- **Pinkie** (Smallest), And Least: Pray For Myself

FIVE PRAYER MODELS

DIVINE READING

- One Method Of Building An Effective Prayer Life Includes Bible Reading And Prayer As Complementary Parts Of One's Devotional Life. Sometimes Referred To As "Divine Reading", It May Be Compared To Feasting On The Word Of God. The Four Steps Are Reading The Bible (Taking A Bite), Meditating On It (Chewing), Praying (Savoring The Word), And Contemplating Its Application So It Becomes A Part Of One's Life (Digesting).
- Reading. Read The Passage Slowly. Pay Attention To The Text. Read It Several Times. Underline Sections That Catch Your Attention.
- Meditating. Try To Grasp The Meaning Of The Passage, Be Aware Of God's Presence In Your Life.
- Praying. Respond To God. Converse With Him About The Passage And His Will. Open Your Heart To God. Share Your Heart, Not A Laundry List Of Needs Or Things You Think You Ought To Pray About.

WHAT IS PRAYER?

- **Prayer Is Man Exercising His Legal Authority On Earth To Invoke Heaven's Influence On The Planet**
- Prayer Is Entering Into Relationship With God So We Can Determine His Will In The Matter And Call His Will Into Existence Upon The Earth
- Prayer Is The Vehicle By Which You Are Meant To Commune With The Invisible God. It Is The Medium Through Which Your Spirit Is Intended To Affect And Be Affected By The Will And Purpose Of The Divine Creator.
- Prevailing Prayer Is God's Ordained Means Of Manifesting His Kingdom And Fulfilling His Plan For Mankind In The Earth

WHAT GIVES US THE RIGHT TO PRAY?

- Our Right To Pray Comes From Both Our Calling In Creation And Our Redemption In Christ.
- Through Christ We Have A Right To Pray With Authority.
- Because Of Adam An Eve's Fall In Genesis, Power Was Transferred To Satan. But Christ, Reclaimed Our Earthly Authority. He Claimed Our Earthly Authority In These Three Ways :
 - Jesus Came As A Man. That He Was Qualified As A Representative Of Earthly Authority.
 - Jesus Was Perfectly Obedient And Sinless. Thus He Was Qualified To Be The Son Of God And To Restore Man's Relationship With The Father By Overcoming Sin And Death Through His Sacrifice On The Cross.
 - Jesus Rose Victoriously. Thus He Was Qualified To Defeat Sin And Satan, Regain Authority Over The Earth, And Be Its Rightful King.

JOHN 16:23-27 KJV

- ²³ And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.
- ²⁴ Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.
- ²⁵ These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father.
- ²⁶ At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you:
- ²⁷ For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God.

JOHN 16:23-27 TPT

- 23For here is eternal truth: When that time comes you won't need to ask me for anything, but instead you will go directly to the Father and ask him for anything you desire and he will give it to you, because of your relationship with me. 24Until now you've not been bold enough to ask the Father for a single thing in my name, but now you can ask, and keep on asking him! And you can be sure that you'll receive what you ask for, and your joy will have no limits!
- 25"I have spoken to you using figurative language, but the time is coming when I will no longer teach you with veiled speech, but I will teach you about the Father with your eyes unveiled. 26And I will not need to ask the Father on your behalf, for you'll ask him directly because of your new relationship with me. 27For the Father tenderly loves you, because you love me and believe that I've come from God.
