The Model Prayer

The Elements Of Jesus Model Prayer Are The Following

OUR FATHER

We bring to God the concerns of others as well as ourselves, acknowledging God as our Source.

IN HEAVEN

We admit we need help from outside our earthly realm- that we need God's help. We depend on Jesus and the Holy Spirit as our intermediaries with God.

HALLOWED BE YOUR NAME

We worship the Father as the Holy One, glorifying all his attributes. We honor him in our lives and dealings with others.

YOUR KINGDOM COME. YOUR WILL BE DONE ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN

We express interest in God's Kingdom and what he wants accomplished before our interests.

GIVE US THIS DAY OUR DAILY BREAD

We ask God to supply the daily needs of others as well as our own and to provide for the process that makes that sustenance possible.

AND FORGIVE US OUR DEBTS, AS WE FORGIVE OUR DEBTORS

We forgive others so that God will also forgive us and will hear and answer our prayers.

AND LEAD US NOT INTO TEMPTATION BUT DELIVER US FROM EVIL

We are alert to temptations and weaknesses that Satan will exploit to harm our relationship with God. We pray that God will protect us from succumbing to them.

FOR THINE IS THE KINGDOM, AND THE POWER, AND THE GLORY, FOREVER. AMEN

We worship the father again, giving him all the glory in advance for answered prayer.

STEP 1

Become Silent.-Be Still And Gather Yourself. If Your Spirit, Body, Mind, And Emotions Are Separated, Then You Will Be Unable To Pray God's Will With Singleness Of Purpose.
Silence Helps Bring You Into Unity With God.

MATTHEW 6:6

But you, when you pray, go into your room, and when you have shut your door, pray to your Father who is in the secret place; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you alopenly.

STEP 2: GIVE ADORATION. WORSHIP GOD FOR WHO HE IS.

PSALMS 95:1-7

- ¹Let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our salvation.
- ²Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving;
- Let us shout joyfully to Him with psalms.
- ³ For the LORD *is* the great God, And the great King above all gods.

- ⁴In His hand *are* the deep places of the earth;
- ⁵ The sea *is* His, for He made it; And His hands formed the dry *land*.
- ⁶Oh come, let us worship and bow down;
- Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.
- ⁷ For He *is* our God,
- And we are the people of His pasture,
- And the sheep bof His hand.

Step 3: Make Confession. Agree With God About What He Says To You And About You. This Is Where God Reveals Our Heart To Us.

<u>1JOHN 1:9</u>

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

ROMANS 8:33-34 NKJV

33 Who shall bring a charge against God's elect? *It is* God who justifies.

34 Who *is* he who condemns? *It is* Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

STEP 4

Give Thanks. Offer Sacrifices Of Praise To God With A Free Heart For All That He Has Done For You

1 THESSALONIANS 5:16-18

- ¹⁶ Rejoice always,
- ¹⁷ Pray without ceasing,
- ¹⁸ In everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

STEP 5

Make Supplication. As God Shows You What He Desires, Wholeheartedly Agree With Him In Prayer To Fulfill His Will.

PHILIPPIANS 4:6

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

STEP 6

Specify Petitions And Requests. Be Specific. Find Evidence In The Word That Is Relevant To The Case.

1 JOHN 5:14-15

- 14 Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us.
- ¹⁵ And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.

STEP 7

Secure The Promises. Find A Promise In God's Word That Apply

2 CORINTHIANS 1:20

²⁰ For all the promises of God in Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us

Step 8: Plead The Case. Don't Beg But Pray Intelligently Because You Rightfully Deserve The Answer Based On Gods' Promises. Not Blindly Standing, But Standing By Faith On The Word Of God.

PSALM 119:105

Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.

MATTHEW 7:24

Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

Step 8: Plead The Case. Don't Beg But Pray Intelligently Because You Rightfully Deserve The Answer Based On Gods' Promises. Not Blindly Standing, But Standing By Faith On The Word Of God.

Step 9: BELIEVE. DON'T WAVER. DON'T BE DOUBLE MINDED. LET WHAT YOU SPEAK REFLECT WHAT YOU BELIEVE.

⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. ⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. ⁷ For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord;

Step 9: BELIEVE. DON'T WAVER. DON'T BE DOUBLE MINDED. LET WHAT YOU SPEAK REFLECT WHAT YOU BELIEVE.

You will also declare a thing, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

STEP 10

Give Thanks. Thank God For What You Don't Yet See Because You Believe It Is Already Done.

MARK 11: 22 - 24

- ²² So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God.
- ²³ For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.
- ²⁴ Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive *them*, and you will have *them*

STEP 11

Live In Expectation.

Prepare For The Answer.

EPHESIANS 3:20

Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us,

STEP 12

Practice Active Belief. After You Pray, Get Up And Look For What You Asked For And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

HURDLES AND HINDRANCES TO ANSWERED PRAYER

Prayer Is The Greatest Opportunity And Privilege Offered To A Believer Of Christ. Yet Because Of The Power Of Prayer, The Adversary Makes It His Business To See That The Prayers Of Individuals And Churches Are Ineffective. Satan Knows That A Church Is Only As Powerful As It's Prayer Life. Therefore, He Will Use Misconceptions About Prayer To Hinder The Great Potential Of Prayer.

(a) When Our Hope Is Not The Biblical Kind But Is Really Just Wishful Thinking .

²⁸ But the same servant went out, and found one of his fellowservants, which owed him an hundred pence: and he laid hands on him, and took him by the throat, saying, Pay me that thou owest.

²⁹ And his fellowservant fell down at his feet, and besought him, saying, Have patience with me, and I will pay thee all.

³⁰ And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

- ³¹ So when his fellowservants saw what was done, they were very sorry, and came and told unto their lord all that was done.
- ³² Then his lord, after that he had called him, said unto him, O thou wicked servant, I forgave thee all that debt, because thou desiredst me:
- 33 Shouldest not thou also have had compassion on thy fellowservant, even as I had pity on thee?
- ³⁴ And his lord was wroth, and delivered him to the tormentors, till he should pay all that was due unto him.
- ³⁵ So likewise shall my heavenly Father do also unto you, if ye from your hearts forgive not every one his brother their trespasses.
